#### **Monitoring and assessment of projects**

With great honor, we write to report to our noble team that in the month of August, 2022, we were able to visit a number of our beneficiary groups and individuals in the community and here are the observations.

As reported earlier, our beneficiaries are involved in a number of activities such as horticulture, poultry farming, piggery, fish mongering, selling vegetables, bricklaying, tailoring, local brewing, hawking of second hand clothes and shoes, ripe bananas, small restaurants, retail shops and many others and their involvement is leading to general improvement of household income hence improving their standards of living and as they service their soft loans too.

Members are able to make profits out of PAUTHO soft loans since it is almost interest free and the mode of repayment is very conducive to recover compared to other credit institutions. Our soft loans are said to be a consolation to our beneficiaries as they have been oppressed by many financial institutions as they needed funds which could help them change their livelihood.

PAUTHO organization is bridging the gap of high illiteracy rate in the communities of Bukiende Sub County. Vulnerable mothers who are the beneficiaries of the organization are now able to meet school requirements for their children since they are involved in Income Generating Activities (IGA).

### **Achievements**

As most of our beneficiaries are testifying the goodness of Pautho vision as an organization, Lunyolo Juliet from Shikoye Isango Women Group gives credit to our organization for considering her being a single parent who was dumped by her husband and as we write to you today she has bought iron sheets where she used part of the money got from Pautho in form of a soft loan meanwhile her project is growing steadily.

### **Loan Recoveries**

Amidst this hard economy associated with high inflation, members are working together in their groups to make sure that they remit their soft loans though there are some few groups which are struggling but we are extending financial guidance to enable them recover their loans accordingly.

### **Loan Disbursement**

This being our major activity and we are here to let our team know that some amount of money was given to individuals and groups that have shown interest and these include; Lutembete Ambanilakho women farmers' group (New group), Lutembete Women Association farmers group, Wapondo Tsowatsowana Farmers' group, Bumaliro Bamayi yetana farmers' group Shikoye Isango women group and among others. We are considering more new groups which were left behind to come on board since we have covered all the parishes of Bukiende Sub County.

### **Conclusion**

In summary, we do express our inmost gratitude to our donors for their continued support towards the welfare of vulnerable women through the organization. The organization is covering the wider part of Bukende Sub County that is to say 6/7 parishes with around 42 groups.
