Projects Assessment

We are pleased to report to our noble team that during February, we mobilized and sensitized new members/groups in the areas of Nyondo, Nabumali TC and Bukiende and some have formed and submitted in their files for considerations.

We also assessed several beneficiary groups and individuals in Nyondo sub county and Nabumali Town council and here are some of our observations;

The beneficiary members invested the money in business projects like, Stalls, food vending, small restaurants, fish mongering, poultry farming, piggery, bricklaying, tailoring, local brewing, hawking of secondhand clothes and shoes, retail shops, and among others. And as result, there is gradual improvement in their household income, hence improving their standards of living.

Members are using their profits to meet other needs like school fees and home necessities, hence crediting our organization for the kind loans extended to them.

We also resorted to take some of the defaulting members (i.e Irene Khatundi from Buyaka integrated women's group and some other members from Ikyenga Tubaana women group) to police and as a result, Irene has paid some money.

Loan Recoveries

In February, we recovered some amount of money from our beneficiaries as agreed in the repayment schedule and at their willingness to repay and apply for another loan for those who have cleared. We gladly report to the team that our beneficiaries are very positive and cooperative in recovering their soft loans from our organization amidst other financial challenges.

Loan Disbursement

After recoveries from the beneficiaries plus the monthly remittance by the organization (Funders), we were able to disburse some amount of money to other groups and individuals that applied.

Our loans are disbursed to only groups that meet the requirements as per the organization and after financial guidance being extended to them.
