Loan Recoveries

We would like to report that some few groups are complying in making their monthly repayments and others really need pressure behind in order for them to make payments, and at least a few have turned up to work on it by clearing their open loans though not as fast as the company's expectations and for those who worked well are still waiting in case the company says we are considering them again then we shall work together with the new rules set.

We have gone ahead towards looking for best measures so that we can run this smoothly and we have gone a head us an organization to involve the courts of law and we think this will make our beneficiaries understand that us they become members of the Organization they have to abide by her rules and regulations set by the organization.

Loan Disbursement

As we have reported from the previous 4months Pautho soft loans were put on hold due to many outstanding open loans from a number of groups and they only gave a chance to a few individuals and only the staff of Kwa Moyo to have access to soft loans.

We would like to inform the team that in the month of January Pautho as an organization hired a professional lawyer who signed a contract, whom the organization is looking forward to work with in case some beneficiaries default their dates as agreed in the agreements made during disbursement day.
